Body Plan

Radial Symmetry Polyp – shaped like vase, mouth at top. Don't move around (hydra, coral) Medusa – mouths open downward, bowl shaped (jellyfish)

Feeding Methods

- 1. Stinging cells inject venom into its prey.
- 2. Venom paralyzes prey.
- 3. Tentacles pull food into mouth.
- 4. Only have one opening so undigested food goes out the same opening food comes in.
