
I. Three Stages of the Nile River

- A. Inundation (June-September)
 - 1. Floods began
 - 2. Egyptians celebrated
 - 3. Worked on building projects



- 1. Returning waters
- 2. Trapped water in ponds
- 3. Planted seeds in mud
 - a. one farmer would plow soil
 - b. another farmer would throw seeds
 - c. animals would trample seeds in ground
 - d. another farmer would smooth the ground

C. Drought (February-June)

- 1. Nile would be normal
- 2. People would harvest crops

D. Importance of flooding

- 1. normal
 - a. times were good
- 2. below normal
 - a. less land was watered
 - b. fewer crops
 - c. starvation
