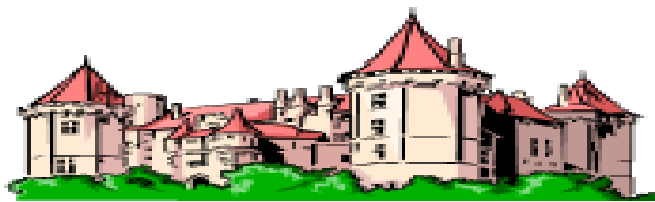
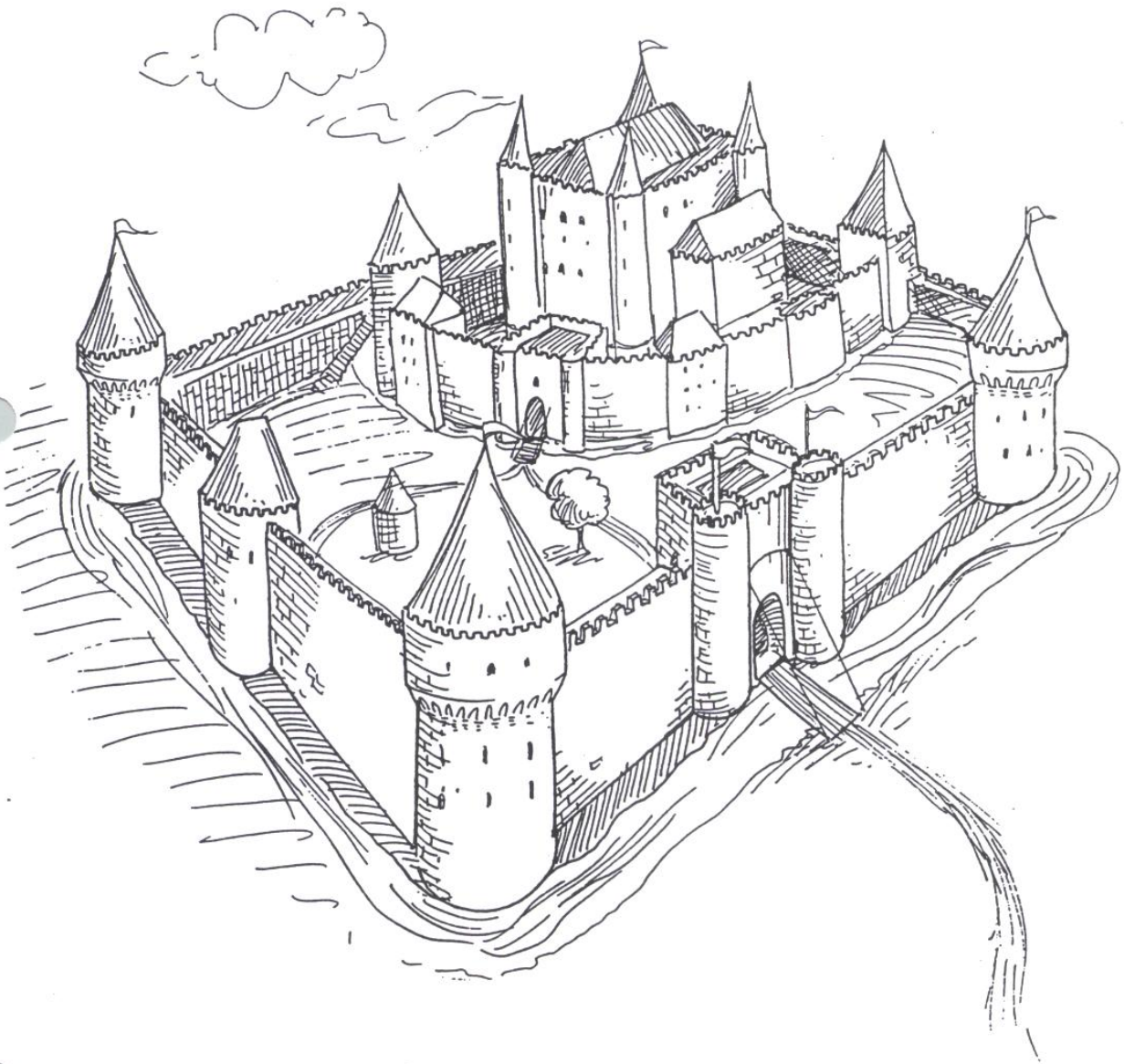


### Castle Vocabulary

Outer wall –	surrounds both the village and the castle
Inner wall –	surrounds the castle
Keep –	living quarters for the noble
Moat –	ditch filled with water
Drawbridge –	covers the moat, can be lifted for protection
Gatehouse –	first form of defense, houses the drawbridge
Bailey –	courtyard
Arrow Loops –	narrow slit for archers to shoot through
Tower –	used for storage or living in
Chapel –	place of worship
Dungeon –	to hold prisoners
Armory –	where weapons were stored
Great Hall –	used for meeting and eating
