Outer wall – surrounds both the village and the castle

Inner wall – surrounds the castle

Keep - living quarters for the noble

Moat - ditch filled with water

Drawbridge - covers the moat, can be lifted for protection

Gatehouse - first form of defense, houses the drawbridge

Bailey – courtyard

Arrow Loops - narrow slit for archers to shoot through

Tower - used for storage or living in


Chapel – place of worship

Dungeon – to hold prisoners

Armory – where weapons were stored

Great Hall – used for meeting and eating
